

DIRECTIONS TO CENTRE FOR CROSS BORDER STUDIES, 39 ABBEY STREET, ARMAGH

The Centre for Cross Border Studies is situated in the large grey building at the junction of Abbey Street and Dawson Street and adjacent to St Patrick's Church of Ireland Cathedral.

From M1 Motorway

- leave motorway at Exit 11
- follow signs to Armagh from Portadown (A3)
- approaching Armagh take second exit on mini-roundabout
- continue past Armagh Planetarium (on right) and Armagh Courthouse (on right)
- take second exit at mini-roundabout (straight ahead)
- continue to top of hill and follow road to the right to another mini-roundabout
- take first exit on left at mini-roundabout beside the Fire Station
- proceed up Dawson Street to the Centre for Cross Border Studies which is in the building on the right at the top of the hill

From Dungannon/Moy

- continue to end of main Moy/Armagh road to roundabout at Maxol garage (on left)
- take the third exit through pedestrian traffic lights and continue straight
- immediately past Jet garage (on left), turn right
- continue straight to mini roundabout and take second exit up the hill (at Fire Station)
- the Centre for Cross Border Studies is in the building at the right hand side at top of hill

From Newry

- continue to end of main Newry/Armagh road, straight down hill past Police Station (on left)
- turn left following signs for Omagh/Enniskillen
- continue for approx ½ mile, Armagh City Hotel on left, follow road through traffic lights
- turn right
- at T-junction (church ahead), turn left and follow road through traffic lights
- continue to follow the road which will narrow - wall on left, Youth Hostel on immediate left
- the next building on the left houses the Centre for Cross Border Studies

From Aughnacloy/Caledon

- follow the Killylea Road to Armagh
- approaching Armagh continue through pedestrian traffic lights past Spar garage (on left)
- turn left at signs for Monaghan and Keady
- at T-junction (church ahead), turn left and follow road through traffic lights
- continue to follow the road which will narrow - wall on left, Youth Hostel on immediate left
- the next building on the left houses the Centre for Cross Border Studies

From Monaghan/Keady

- from Monaghan continue to the end of the road
- at T-junction turn left following signs for Armagh (A3)
- continue straight along road, past Esso Garage (on left) and under bridge following signs for City Centre
- continue straight through traffic lights
- follow the road which will narrow - wall on left, Youth Hostel on immediate left
- the next building on the left houses the Centre for Cross Border Studies

PARKING

The Centre for Cross Border Studies car park is to the side of the building. Spaces are limited and allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. Parking is also available at the Youth Hostel, just beside the building.

There are a number of Council Car Parking Sites. Those closest to the Centre are off Dawson Street and at St Patrick's Trian.

N.B. Disabled car parking spaces are available at the front of the building.
